

2015 Archery League Rules

1. **Equipment – “Shoot What You Bring”**
2. **Length of 2015 league season** – Season starts the week of May 31 through the week of August 2. (10 weeks)
3. **League fees for 2015**

Lifetime Memberships \$10.00 archery maintenance fee plus \$25.00 archery league fee. (\$35.00)

Yearly Memberships \$30.00 membership fee, \$10.00 archery maintenance fee (spouse and children under 18 are included) plus \$25.00 archery league fee. (\$65.00)

Under age 18 with no family membership (membership fee of \$30.00 will be waived) \$10.00 archery maintenance fee plus \$25.00 archery league fee. (\$35.00)

Please send all fees with your signup sheet and return in envelope provided. Anyone not having a membership at time of sign up will have their scores discarded and zero entered for scores.

4. **League shooting times** – Shooters will have from sunup on Monday to noon on Saturday to shoot your league score for that week. If there is a 3-D shoot on that week end scores must be shot by sundown on Friday. 3-D shoot schedule will be posted on the practice range and a copy will also be sent with your signup sheet. Please note that if you are shooting on Thursday or Friday of a 3-D shoot week end, please watch for set up crews on the course preparing for the shoot. Completed score cards will be deposited in the drop box that is mounted to the east, outside wall of the club house. Score cards with no names or team names will be discarded. The first 2 weeks will be used for pool scores which will be used first in the event that you miss a week due to vacation, work schedule changes, etc. Shooters that do not shoot or turn in a score card after using the 2 pool scores will automatically be given 80% of their average.

Shooters will be able to make up a missed week, either the week before or after scheduled week, except for week #10, which must be made up the week before only.

Make sure you put the correct week # on the card.

5. **Scoring of the targets** - 10 for a heart, 5 for a kill and 0 for a miss or non-lethal shot (outside the heart, lung, liver area). Arrows touching a scoring line on the outside will count as the higher score.
6. **League round** - 45 arrows will be shot for a complete league round. First round shot each week will be your league round. No you can't shoot the course 3 times and turn in the best round.
7. Binoculars will be allowed. Please, no range finders.
8. Anyone caught shooting anything other than the assigned targets, this includes buildings, tree stands, animals out of season, will be asked to leave the club grounds and their membership will be suspended. Let's set good examples for our youth.
