Youth League (Ages 12-15) High School League (Ages 15-17).

Also available is our youth pellet gun and archery range for any age (upon OCC instructor's judgment). Pellet guns and Genesis bows will be provided.

When: May 19 at 6:00p.m. for sign-up, orientation, and safety meeting. Attendance on **May 19 is mandatory**. A parent or guardian must sign a waiver. Hunter safety is not required to shoot but is recommended. Only a limited amount of individual shooters and teams of five will be allowed. We will shoot on the following Monday evenings: June 2, 16, 23; July 7, 21, 28; and August 4, 11, 18. The Banquet will be held on August 23. Trophies and first year awards will be given out that night.

First year shooters: Welcome to the O.C.C. Youth Trap League. You will be individually shooting the game of trap. (First year shooters that have not previously shot trap, skeet, or sporting clays. Please honor this privilege as we are trying to introduce our young people to the sport). If you wish to form a 5 man squad it is permitted. There is no cost for first year shooters, for shells or clay targets, thanks to generous donations from our sponsors. This is a privilege and we ask that you respect it.

Second year shooters: Welcome back! Second year shooters are allowed to have teams of up to 5 shooters and 3 subs. Sponsorships are not needed for teams, but if you would like to get shooting vests or pouches try to get someone to sponsor your team. Cost is \$6.50 for a box of shells and 1 round of trap. No first year shooters privileges allowed!

High School Shooters: Teams consist of 5 persons and 3 subs. Cost is \$7.00 (including clays & shells). Sponsorships are not needed for teams, but you would like to get shooting vests or pouches try to get someone to sponsor your team. You must be between the ages of 15-17 to be in the High School League.

**Note- High School first year shooters will be charged \$6.50 for clays and shells. **

This year, the club is going to start a traveling trophy for the High School League.

Pre-registration is possible, but limited and is based on first come first serve basis.

Range & Gun Rules

- Guns are not permitted in the clubhouse.
- When not in use, guns can be stored in the gun racks or in a personal vehicle. OCC is not responsible for lost or stolen guns or personal equipment.
- All actions must remain open with empty chambers when moving to and from the shooting line and from station to station.
- All actions must remain open until it is your turn to shoot.
- A live round may be placed in the open chamber, however the action will remain open until it is your turn to shoot.
- Only the five (5) shooters, the puller, and two mentors will be allowed on the field during the shooting. All others must remain behind the white fence.
- Only trap loads of 7 ½ or smaller shot (1 1/8oz.; 3 dram equivalent) will be allowed.
- No one is allowed to pick up spent shells while the squad is shooting. Pick up empty shells after the round is completed. Please keep the area clean.
- All semi-automatics must be equipped with a shell catcher.
- Misbehavior will not be tolerated and the shooter(s) will be barred from shooting on first offense.

First year shooters (Beginners)

- First year shooters will be individually shooting the game of trap.
- Qualifying shooters are shooters that have not previously shot trap, sporting clays or skeet.
- Please honor this privilege as we are trying to introduce our young people to the sport.
- If you wish to form a 5-man squad it is permitted.
- First year shooters are allowed to shoot one round for free (25 clays and 1 box of shells) every week during the Youth League.
- Eleven Mossberg 20 gauge pump action shotguns are available for use for any shooters who don't own a gun.
- Adult volunteers would be appreciated.

Second year shooters

- Teams consist of 5 persons, at least 1 sub and a team name.
- No team needs to be sponsored but if you wish to have one for shooting vests or pouches.
- Cost subject to clay target prices and shotshell prices at club's cost.
- Adult volunteers would be appreciated.

League Information

- Shooters may only shoot on one team.
- Teams must shoot together for league round.
- Team captains are responsible for signing up the team and collecting the shooting fees.
- Squad sheets will not be submitted until all shooters are present.
- Only one sheet may be turned in at a time
- Teams will be assigned to the first available trap in the order they were submitted.
- Team names and trap numbers will be called prior to shooting. All shooters must be ready to move onto the line with the previous team finishes.
